- Operate as a Foreman in the installation, maintenance, and de-installation of all aspects of wireless cell site foundations including grounding conduits, electrical installations, site de-installation of antennas, coax, and BTS cabinets
- Perform lead responsibilities and effectively interface with all levels of management, staff, and customer requirements
- Conducting performance checks and regular maintenance – maintaining, repairing, and occasionally installing various cell tower types
- Complete assigned tasks within project scope accurately and efficiently
- Must be able to work at heights 90' to 500+'; maintain efficient weatherproofing, grounding, and rigging techniques
- Participate in and carry out installation, repair, modification, optimization, or acceptance test procedures of wireless infrastructures and electrical equipment
- Install all types of connectors
- Maintain proper installation, troubleshooting, and repair techniques
- Performing additional maintenance or upgrades on out of season equipment
- Facilitate teaching crew members proper techniques in top and bottom of cell site
- Learn how to analyze and interpret site data
- Become skilled/familiar with test equipment (Sweeps, PIM, Fiber, Microwave, etc.)
- Isolate basic hardware, software, and air interface malfunctions utilizing various test equipment on multiple products and technologies
- Ability to travel for multiple days with Per Diem depending on the project
